PGA Annual Meeting Recap

The 99th PGA Annual Meeting was held in Palm Beach Gardens and as is the case with an off-year as far as elections, the primary focus was on reporting on the activities and programs for the Association. Included in the first day's sessions were updates on PGA Junior Golf League, the plans for the PGA Centennial, an explanation of PGA Verified (a vehicle for approving and educating members with regard to technology products and services) and an explanation of the coalition of the NGCOA and PGA to establish and monitor tee time guidelines. The keynote speaker was Dave Ridley, Chief Marketing Officer of Southwest Airlines while formal presentations were made to Deane Beman for the PGA Distinguished Service Award and Jack Connelly in recognition as a Legend of the PGA.

In addition to the business conducted, the meeting included a night of honoring the 2015 Special Awards recipients including our own Tom Henderson as the 2015 PGA Professional of the Year. The next night, the Hall of Fame induction ceremony honored Payne Stewart, George Hannon, Charlie Sifford, Tommy Bolt, Michael Doctor, Ray Cutright and Lee Trevino. The Trevino interview with Jimmy Roberts was priceless and demonstrated his love and passion for the PGA Professional.

In other business there were a total of 4 resolutions that were passed by consent (involving the representation by the PGA President on the Champions Tour Board, the elimination of Player Directors as Delegates, the removal of obsolete wording under Powers and Duties of the Board and clarification of the selection of Honorary Members and Honorary Directors). Two resolutions introduced by Sections failed to gain approval. Middle Atlantic and Carolinas had proposed a limit on the # of hours that could be attained for MSR online while Northern Texas had suggested the establishment of a Life Member Emeritus for long-tenured professionals retiring from a facility. The meeting also included a site visit to see the new clubhouse at PGA Golf Village along with golf for the delegates and attendees. Please remember that the 100th 2016 PGA Annual Meeting will be next November in New York City.

USGA Rules Changes for 2016

Every 4 years the USGA and R&A collaborate on changes to the Rules of Golf. Obviously we have all heard about the changes to 14-1B on anchoring, but there have been other changes as well. Among the changes are Rule 18-2b (Ball moving after address). In the new interpretation, a one stroke penalty under 18-2b will be applied only when the facts show that the player has caused the ball to move. Under Rule 6-6d a new exception has been introduced to provide that a player is not disqualified for returning a lower score for a hole than actually taken as a result of failing to include penalty strokes that the player did not know were incurred before returning the card. In Rule 14-3 the penalty for the first infraction of the use of artificial devices or equipment has been modified from disqualification to loss of hole in match play or two strokes in stroke play. Subsequent breaches will result in disqualification. Professionals can visit USGA.org for additional details and video explanations of these changes.

Dates are as follows: Quarter Century Championship (Jan. 6-7, 2016 – entry deadline is Dec. 16th); Senior Stroke Play Championship (Jan. 12-14, 2016 – entry deadline is Dec. 16th); Senior-Junior Team Championship (Jan. 19-22, 2016 – entry deadline is Jan. 13th), Women's Stroke Play Championship (Feb. 2-4, 2016 – entry deadline is Jan. 20th), Stroke Play Championship (Feb. 2-5, 2016 – entry deadline is Jan. 20th) and Match Play Championship (Feb. 9-12, 2016 – entry deadline is Jan. 28th).PGA Professionals who have made contributions to Special Olympics are encouraged to apply for the Conrad Rehling Award. Applications are due in by Jan. 15th to Caroline Blackwood at the PGA Foundation [click here](#)..... The FALL PAK for PGA Members has been sent and professionals should soon be receiving the mailing that includes the 2016 PING PGA Appointment Calendar..... Tournament News

The finals of the Web.Com Tour Qualifying, will be Dec. 10th – 13th at PGA National Golf Club in Palm Beach Gardens, FL. Former MGA Player of the Year and a star on the Met PGA Junior Tour, David Pastore will be joined by the sons of two of our professionals – Michael Miller, son of Knollwood's Bob Miller and Marc Turnesa, son of Rockville Links' Mike Turnesa Jr.

Two of our long-time top professionals and former Section champions, Charlie Bolling and Mark Mielke will be at TPC Scottsdale, Champions Course in Scottsdale, Arizona for the finals of the Champions Tour Qualifying tournament on Dec. 1st – 4th. Bolling advanced from the Texas Qualifier where he was tied for 14th while Mielke advanced from the Florida qualifier where he was tied for 12th. This finale is arguably the hardest of all the tour qualifyings with such a limited number of spots onto the Champions Tour.

The PGA TOUR Latinoamerica Tour Championship takes place in Puerto Rico on Dec. 3rd – 6th with Danny Balin still fighting for one of the coveted top 5 spots to gain access to the Web.com Tour. Balin currently sits 11th on the money list and has one win already on the circuit.

The 2015 PGA Tournament Series Presented by GOLFADVISOR is underway starting on Nov. 30th and Dec. 1st with the first event at the Wanamaker Course in PGA Golf Village. Event #2 (Dec. 3-4) moves to The Dye Course; The deadline for Event #3 (Dec. 7-8) at the Ryder Course is Dec. 1st. Event #4 (Dec. 10-11) is back at the Wanamaker and the entry deadline is Dec. 4th. Event #5 (Dec. 14-15) returns to The Dye Course with an entry deadline of Dec. 8th while the series concludes at The Ryder Course with event #6 (Dec. 17-18) and the final deadline is Dec. 11th. The PGA series will also help determine the PGA Club Professional Player of the Year with Matt Dobyans currently leading in the point race.
