Met PGA HOPE is a six-week adaptive golf program offered free of charge by PGA Professionals that utilizes golf as a rehabilitation tool to improve our veterans' quality of life by enhancing their mental, social, physical, and emotional well-being.

After graduating the Met PGA HOPE program, our veterans are given a set of golf clubs to continue their golf journey, they are invited to play in our Military Golf League, and we encourage them to use their PGA HOPE Card to receive discounts at area golf courses and ranges.

PGA HOPE falls under the umbrella of the Metropolitan PGA Section Foundation, a 501 C-3 nonprofit organization. With the assistance of donations we strive to positively impact the veterans of the Metropolitan area one swing at a time.

Met PGA HOPE currently has six programs in three locations and serves over 200 military veterans.

Since 2007, Folds of Honor has carried forth this singular, noble mission: to stand in the financial gap of the more than one million dependents adversely affected by war.
