Craig Thomas Ties for Low Club Professional Honor at PGA Seniors at Harbor Shores

Congratulations to Craig Thomas who rolled in a 40-footer on his the 18th hole to share the low club professional honors with Bob Friend of the Tri-State Section. Craig was actually the low finisher of the club professionals who had gained eligibility through the recent PGA Senior Professional Championship while Friend had gotten into the field through last year's Champions Tour qualifying and then his 2014 money earnings. Mark Mielke also played well but just missed the 36-hole cut by 2 strokes. Thomas posted rounds of 71-74-70-72 for a 287 total and tie for 33rd overall was recognized both on NBC and then again in the final awards ceremony on the 18th green with champion Colin Montgomerie.



KPMG Women's PGA Championship Coming to Westchester CC in June of 2015

We are excited to announce a landmark moment for the PGA for a partnership with the LPGA and KPMG to create the KPMG Women's PGA Championship. The week will bring together a world-class, annual major golf championship with a women's leadership summit and an ongoing community initiative to inspire and develop new generations of female leaders.

The KPMG Women's PGA Championship, broadcast in partnership with NBC and Golf Channel, will continue the rich tradition of the LPGA Championship and will rotate annually among prestigious courses in major metropolitan markets. In its first year, the Championship will be held June 8-14, 2015 at Westchester Country Club in Rye, New York, with a purse among the highest in women's golf at \$3.5 million. The Championship will be operated by the PGA of America in close collaboration with the LPGA. Also there will be qualifying spots for women PGA as well as LPGA club professionals.

PGA Warns of Unauthorized Facility Use for Commercial Purposes

It has been brought to our attention by the PGA of America that a company, Prep Sportswear, is using golf facility names and addresses in the attempt to sell merchandise via their website without proper authorization from the facility. We suggest that you check to see if your facility is included in their catalogues and if they are using the facility name without authorization, we suggest that your facility legal counsel should take the necessary legal steps to protect the facility from this type of practice.

Lincoln Met PGA Section Championship Pro-Am Lottery Begins on June 15th

Our Lincoln Met PGA Championship will be at Glen Oaks Club on Sept. 15th – 17th. Our Championship Pro-Am that benefits our Junior Golf programs will also be at this very special and outstanding club on Monday, Aug. 11th. We know that the incredible renovations at Glen Oaks and the outstanding conditions will be an attraction so we anticipate that the field will be oversubscribed. Entry will be by lottery with online registration (not payment) beginning on June 15th and July 10th will be the deadline to submit an entry into the lottery and at that time we will determine what nines will be utilized. Teams will be drawn on the 10th and announced as of July 11th with payments due to the Met PGA Junior Golf Association (a 501 C-3 charitable foundation) by July 26th. We do not anticipate the need to limit the field to having only 1 team per club however, we will provide priority on morning or afternoon shotguns on that basis. Because of Glen Oaks having 27 holes, we feel we may be able to maximize participation this year. The decision of what nines will be included will be based on the number of entries to avoid eliminating any teams that would like to attend.
