Conditions of the Competition
Benefitting "Folds of Honor"

1. Eligibility: Each village (all villages, hamlets, City of Glen Cove & City of Long Beach are eligible) on Long Island is eligible to enter up to 2 foursomes of amateurs. **Teams must have at least two players that must be residents of the village they are representing.**
2. Format-4 Person Scramble:
 - All four team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.
 - The other team members pick up their balls and place them within one club length (no closer to the hole) of the marked spot. Each team member hits their next shot from the chosen spot of the prior shot.
 - This procedure is followed on every shot for the remainder of the hole, including putts. The ball should be marked on the putting green also.
 - Putts need to be made within 3 inches of the marked spot (no closer to the hole). The first ball to go in the hole is counted for the team score.
 - If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard (sand, water, etc.), or the rough you cannot drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.
 - Each team must use at least one of each team members tee shots on each nine (minimum two tee shots per player).
 - Men tee off from the blue tees.
 - **All rules interpretations will be handled and resolved by the Lawrence Yacht & Country Club Golf Professional Staff.**
3. Schedule: Player registration will begin at 10:00 AM. All practice facilities and golf shop will open at 10:00 AM. The tournament will be a 12:00 PM Shotgun with a barbeque dinner following play at 5:00 PM.
4. Times of Starting: 12:00 PM Shotgun.
5. How to Decide Ties: Ties for The Championship will be decided by a closest to pin contest on hole 18. Each team member will participate. The closest shot to pin wins the tournament.
6. Handicaps: The Championship will be played at scratch (no handicaps).
7. Prizes: First Place Team will take home Long Island Village Championship Trophy to be displayed for one year at a location of their choosing. 3 Gross Team Prizes.
8. Golf Carts & Caddies: All players must take a golf cart. Fore caddies will be available.
9. **City of Long Beach the 2016 Long Island Village Champions will have the honor of starting on hole number one.**
